OVER 64?? PLEASE READ!!

If you have reached **age 65** and **own** your property and **occupy** the property, you are eligible for a savings of about **\$845** on your annual real estate tax bill. The **SENIOR HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION (SHE)** is administered through the Township Assessors' Offices. To apply, come down to the Waukegan Township Assessor's Office at 415 Washington Street Suite 206 (second floor) or call us at (847) 623-4550. You will need to bring a copy of the deed to the property (or the actual deed & we will copy it) when you apply.

You may also be eligible for the **SENIOR CITIZENS ASSESSMENT FREEZE HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION** (the "FREEZE") which has been in effect since 1994. Its requirements are the same as the (SHE), but also requires **annual household income of \$55,000 or less**. The application forms for year **2016**, based on 2015 **total household** income are available at the Waukegan Township Assessor's Office.

Waukegan Township Ban/No Trespass Policy

When it is determined that residents or non-residents of the Township as an employee, visitor or client, presents an ongoing threat to the Township, the Township may issue a "No Trespass Notice" restricting that person from any property owned or controlled by the Township for a period of time to be determined on a case-by-case basis. Failure to comply with the notice will result in arrest pursuant to 720 ILCS 5/21-5, or any applicable city ordinance. For more information please contact the Supervisor's office at 847-244-4900.


